Breast Cancer 3-Day Walk

On October 24-26, 2008, I along with several thousand other people will be walking 60 miles in the Atlanta Breast Cancer 3-Day to raise money to support the Breast Cancer 3-Days benefit Susan G. Komen for the Cure to fund breast cancer research, education, screening and treatment programs, as well as the National Philanthropic Trust Breast Cancer Fund, to provide an endowment for breast cancer initiatives.

Unfortunately, breast cancer has become an all too common occurrence among women and men throughout the world. In 2007, according to Susan G. Komen for the Cure, more than 200,000 women and 1,700 men in the U.S. were diagnosed with breast cancer. About 40,000 women and 460 men died from the disease. Breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death for all women, and the leading cause of death in women between the ages of 40 and 55. Both its cause and the means for its cure remain undiscovered. Currently, one million women in the U.S. have the disease and probably won't know about their potentially fatal illness for another five to eight years. Breast cancer has challenged 2 million survivors in the United States.

Each participant walking commits to raising a minimum of \$2,200 toward the cause. All donations are tax deductible. Several Lockridge Forest residents other than myself are walking this year. If you know someone who is walking, please donate to them.
